

## **Israel Studies Research Grants**

### **Call for Applications**

The Crown Family Center for Jewish and Israel Studies invites applications for Israel Studies Research Grants. These grants provide Northwestern faculty, graduate students, and undergraduate students with support for research in the field of Israel Studies. Research projects may address any aspect of the history, culture, or society of modern Israel. Projects focused on STEM fields, economics, entrepreneurship, psychology, media and communications, and other fields impacting Israeli society will also be considered. Grants are available for both individual projects, as well as joint-research initiatives with counterparts at Israeli colleges and universities.

### **Award details**

The number of funded projects and level of funding will be determined based on the number and scope of applications.

Funding may include, but is not limited to, travel costs and project costs.

- Grants for faculty are capped at \$15,000
- Grants for graduate students are capped at \$10,000
- Grants for undergraduate students are capped at \$5,000

### **Eligibility**

Open to full-time Northwestern faculty, graduate, and undergraduate students, from any discipline.

### **Application details**

The next application deadline is **January 31, 2019**.

A committee of the Crown Family Center for Jewish and Israel Studies faculty will review the applications for funding. Applicants will be notified within 4 – 6 weeks of the deadline.
